

Child Safe Policy

Title	Content
Purpose	The intention of this policy is to set protocols for child safe practices and inform everyone who works at Race Pace of their obligations and responsibilities to keep children safe.
Scope and audience	This policy applies to all participants at Race Pace schools including coaches, club members, medical personnel, parents, carers, adults and children.
	All persons who attend Race Pace schools must:
	 Comply with this policy and prioritise the prevention of harm to children and young people
	 Uphold the rights of children and actively empower them to participate to the best of their ability
	 Provide a safe and inclusive environment free from discrimination or harassment
	 Report any breach (of this policy, procedure or Child Safe Code of Conduct) to a coach or the head coach of Race Pace.
	 Take steps to ensure all children can actively contribute to the organisation regardless of their ability, race, gender or cultural background
	 Use positive and encouraging language when working with children
	 Refrain from language that is discriminatory, racist, sexist, offensive or belittling
	 Act on any concerns raised by a child that indicate they may be unsafe
	Avoid situations that place children at risk of harm
	 Refrain from any conduct that is considered abusive, neglectful or grooming
	 Notify and seek approval for any interaction with a child outside our services, either professionally or personally, unless that child is a close family member
	 Hold a Working with Children Check (WWCC) clearance, unless exempt
	 Provide their WWCC number when requested for us to verify.

	Child Safe Administrator (CSA)
	Responsibilities:
	Ensure all coaches have a valid WWCC clearance
	The oversight of child safety at Race Pace
	 Organisation's reporting requirements, including information related to reportable conduct and risk of significant harm
	 Record-keeping and conducting a compliance assessment annually
	 Maintaining records of and distributing copies of child safe policies and procedures to coaches and families of children attending Race Pace Schools, and ensuring everyone knows where Race Pace child safe policies can be found
	 Ensure children and their families are aware of the Race Pace commitment to child safety and its complaint handling process
	 Receiving reports of child safe concerns, complaints or allegations from coaches, children and parents, and are across Race Pace internal and external reporting obligations
	 Ensure child safe recruitment practices are implemented when engaging new coaches or volunteers, and they have met child safe induction requirements, and child safe training as required by Race Pace
	Engage with staff to mitigate risk at Race Pace schools
	Review and improve child safe procedures
	Coaches
	Child Safe Officers (CSO)
	Responsibilities:
	Ensure their WWCC clearance is valid
	 Apply to renew their WWCC within 90 days in advance of the expiration date
	 Provide their WWCC details to Race Pace prior to coaching at Race Pace schools
	 Knows where to access Race Pace child safe documents, including Race Pace Child Safe Code of Conduct
	 Is aware of Race Pace reporting requirements, including information related to reportable conduct and risk of significant harm
Definitions of harm and abuse	It is the responsibility of all participants at Race Pace schools including coaches, club members, medical personnel, parents, carers, adults and children to treat each other with respect and dignity, and to understand that these types of abuse are not tolerated at Race Pace.

	Psychological or emotional abuse.

Reporting thresholds	The head coach can write or receive reports of child safe concerns, complaints or allegations from coaches, children and parents
	Coaches can report child safe concerns to the head coach including complaints from children and parents
	Parents / carers and children can report child safe concerns including complaints to the head coach
	Children can report their concerns to their parents / carers or Race Pace head coach or coaches
